PREPOSITIONS

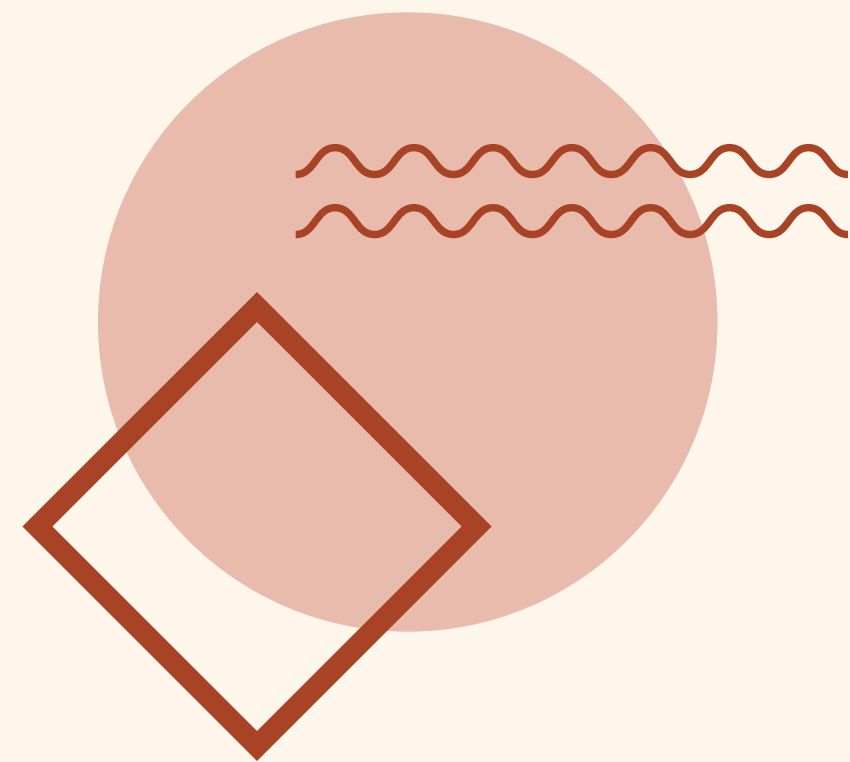
Here are the use of prepositions.

Position	Meaning	Example
In	Inside or within the boundaries of	<i>The library is in the park.</i>
On	Positioned directly above or touching	<i>The flagpole is on the school roof.</i>
At	Specific location or point	<i>The bus stop is at the corner.</i>
Beside	Next to or adjacent to	<i>The café is beside the theatre.</i>
Between	Positioned in the space separating two objects	<i>The playground is between the school and the supermarket.</i>
Behind	Located at the back of	<i>The parking lot is behind the shopping centre.</i>
Across from	Directly opposite	<i>The post office is across from the train station.</i>

EXPRESSIONS WHEN EATING IN A RESTAURANT

There are a couple of phrases often used when eating in a restaurant. Below are the examples.

Making Reservations	• Could we have a table for [number of people], please? • May I book a table for three people? • I'd like to make a reservation for three people.
Arriving and Greeting	• Hello, I have a reservation under Nadia Putri. • Hi, I have a booking under the name of Adam Haris. • Do you have any free tables at the moment.
Inquiring about the Menu	• What are today's specials? • Do you have any house specials? • Could you tell me what's in the pasta salad? • What's the lemon mousse made with?
Ordering	• I'd like to order the [dish or item], please. • Could I have some water, please? • Could I get a refill on my drink? • Could we have the bill/check, please?
